



Uniform Care and Responsibilities



Marching Uniforms

1. Students are responsible for properly wearing and caring for all parts of the uniform including:
 - a. Provided: pants, jacket, hat, t-shirt and raincoat as needed.
 - b. T-shirts are to be worn under the uniform at all times and must have sleeves-no sleeveless T-shirts.
 - c. Student supplies: black marching shoes, black socks (above the ankles), black & white gloves.
 - d. The summer uniform consists of the red Shaker polo shirt (purchased through the fees form), white pants, black belt, black socks and black shoes.
 - e. Gloves are provided at uniform distribution. If lost, new gloves can be purchased for \$5.00.

Uniform Responsibilities

1. Your uniform must be worn properly at all times. The Shaker band is never seen in public in partial uniforms. You are representing the band, your school, and your community. You are responsible for presenting yourself in a way that promotes our goal of being a Class Act. Therefore, students are not permitted to wear partial uniforms at any time.
2. Raincoats will be issued and students are responsible for keeping track of their raincoat number.
3. T-shirts must be worn under the uniform jacket at all times. No sleeveless t-shirts are permitted.
