

Raider Marching Band Checklist

The following items need to be completed by July 24th:

- Review the enclosed Marching Band Roster for your name and instrument.
If there are any errors please contact Gianna Tyrrell or Jason Clemens at 295-4233.
- Return **completed forms and payments** to the band office:
 - Emergency Medical and Permission Form
 - Band Fees form & payment
 - Academy Music form/check (return the enclosed form with a check made payable to **Academy Music**.
***Write a **separate** check for the Academy order; do not include with band fees.)
 - Fall Sports Team Members
 - Band Boosters Volunteer ...sign up through Sign Up Genius
 - Band Boosters Patron Form
 - Senior Day Form (seniors only)

Forms

- Drop-off or mail all forms to the SHHS band office (15911 Aldersyde Dr., Shaker Hts., OH, 44120).

Payment

- Payment can be made via cash, check, or online using the Pay for It system.
- If using Pay For It, return the forms to the band office and you can find the band fees listed under the “Fees” section.

The following items are needed by **Rookie Day, Friday, August 11th** or the start of **Marching Band Camp, Monday, August 14th**:

- **Music Lyre:** Holds music on your instrument.
These can be purchased at most music stores or ordered through Academy Music by returning the enclosed form which is **due by July 24th**.
- **Flip Folder with eight windows** (order three extra windows, they only come with five): Holds music and attaches to your lyre.
These can be purchased at most music stores or ordered through Academy Music by returning the enclosed form which is **due by July 24th**.
- **Instrument in excellent playing condition:** This includes all parts moving, all pads sealing, valve oil, slide grease, extra reeds, etc. If you play a marching instrument supplied by the school, it must be picked up from the band office between **July 31st to August 11th**.

The following items are due by **Game One, August 26th**

- **Black Shoes:** Comfortable shoes that are **all** black.
Recommended shoes are black “Speedsters.” They can be ordered from many websites including Rettig Music, www.rettigmusic.com or (1-800-526-8742). If you order from Rettig, you can pay by credit card and have them delivered to the school at no charge.
- **Black Socks** that cover the ankle. No athletic or “no show” socks.
- **White Pants and a Black Belt:** To be worn with the Shaker Band polo as part of the summer uniform.
Trendy pants, like capris, are not permitted. They must be hemmed so they don’t touch the ground and must be **bright white**, not cream/off-white. Recommended pants are from: Shuttler’s Uniforms (777 Alpha Drive) in Mayfield. They have great uniform pants and free hemming (440-646-9600); or painter’s pants from Sherwin Williams.
- **Band Polo Shirt:** To be worn with the white pants as part of the summer uniform.
*Must be ordered on the Band Fees sheet:
red for non-percussionists, black for percussion. (If you don’t already have one.)
- **Full Marching Uniform:** pants, jacket, suspenders, braid, gloves, hat (berets for tubas), and raincoat
-Or-
- **Percussion Uniform:** pants, tunic shirt, and beret.
You will be given your entire marching uniform during the week of Marching Band Camp; see the uniform fitting schedule on the enclosed Band Calendar.
